What is CCAMPIS?

Authorized by the Higher Education Act and administered by the US Department of Education, CCAMPIS helps lowincome student-parents stay in school and graduate. The project is fully funded by the US Department of Education. IUP was awarded \$164,361 every year for 4 years (2017-2021).

Who is eligible?

- . IUP student-parents enrolled in at least 6 credits per semester
- Pell grant eligible OR an annual family income at or below 200% of the federal poverty guideline

Child Care Scholarship up to 60-90% of total cost covered
